## Wyoming Nonprofit's Sector: Generating Economic Impact

The charitable nonprofit sector directly **employs 16,800** Wyomingites, **7%** of Wyoming's non-government workforce




With direct, indirect, and induced jobs, the total **economic impact** is over **\$2.2 billion\*** in output.

The economic impact of nonprofits goes beyond direct expenditures and employment. To illustrate, legal aid nonprofits contribute to their communities through three different channels (1) direct revenue (e.g., disability compensation by helping individuals navigate complicated government forms), (2) savings to local governments and taxpayers (e.g., avoided costs of homelessness from working to stop an eviction), and (3) savings to households (e.g., value of free legal aid services).

Nonprofits leverage a mix of limited resources, including earned income, private philanthropy, and public funds to maximize community benefit.

There are charitable nonprofit organizations operating in every county in Wyoming. These organizations, defined by the IRS as 501(c)(3), are different than other nonprofits in that they must benefit the broad public interest. There are 3,500 501(c)(3) charitable nonprofits in Wyoming.
